Requirement(s)

1. The student must be a graduating senior for the current academic year with a chosen nursing degree or nursing interest.
2. The student must have proof of collegiate acceptance letter.

Eligible Institutions

- A. Two-Year College
- B. Four-Year College/University
- C. Technical school for post-secondary studies

Required Document(s)

1. Completed application form.
2. Official High School Transcript in a sealed envelope from the high school institution.
3. Two academic reference letters on letter head, no relatives allowed.
4. Proof of community service hours from organization, school, or community organization on letter head for the **prior 3 years**.
5. No application fee required.
